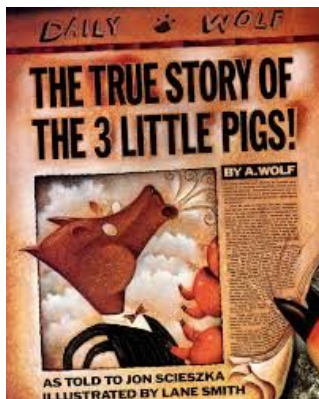


# 6th grade: Twisted Fairy Tale Story Mapping

1. In Google Classroom, I have posted several links to *twisted* fairy tale videos for you to watch or you may just Google “twisted or fractured fairy tales” and watch on YouTube. I also encourage you to actually READ one if you have any at home :)

We are going to focus on the following:

- Setting- where and when does it take place
  - Characters - who are the characters
    - Protagonist - who is the “good guy/girl” in the story
    - Antagonist - who is the “bad guy/girl” in the story
  - Plot - what events happen in the story
  - Problem - what is the problem or struggle the characters face in the story
  - Solution - how does the problem in the story get solved
  - Theme - what is the lesson learned or taught in the story
2. Choose a fairy tale that you like and use the organizer to start planning your version of the story.
    - You need to choose a character different from the main character.
    - It can take place in any setting or time
    - Use the organizer to plan your twisted version of the fairy tale
    - Have fun with this!
  3. Make sure to use the organizer so that your twisted fairy tale has all the elements, a beginning, middle, and end.
  4. Please be detailed and specific for example, Setting - in a forest, once upon a time, castles, houses, trees, flowers, a barn with animals...
  5. If you want to create an illustration, please do!
