

6th grade: Fairy Tale Story Mapping



1. For this week's lessons we are going to focus on fairy tales that we know. In Google Classroom I have posted several links to fairy tale videos for you to watch or you may just Google one of your favorites and watch on YouTube. I also encourage you to actually READ one if you have any at home :) We are going to focus on the following:
 - Setting- where and when does it take place
 - Characters - who are the characters
 - Protagonist - who is the "good guy/girl" in the story
 - Antagonist - who is the "bad guy/girl" in the story
 - Plot - what events happen in the story
 - Problem - what is the problem or struggle the characters face in the story
 - Solution - how does the problem in the story get solved
 - Theme - what is the lesson learned or taught in the story
2. You are going to choose one fairy tale that you like and map it out using the graphic organizer that I provided.
3. Please be detailed and specific for example, Setting - in a forest, once upon a time, castles, houses, trees, flowers, a barn with animals...
4. Then I want you to choose one character from the story, does not have to be the main character. Then fill in the organizer with their character traits and actions.
 - Who, what, when, where, why
5. Submit it in Google Classroom

***Athletics** ~ sports commonly played by children, adults and professionals, the history of the major sport, games they learn in school (PE??)

***Professional Teams** ~ professional sports teams, history of the team, key players, gender, social class

***Olympics & Olympians** ~ If your country hosted the Olympics, when, and were records set. Famous athletes because of their performance.

***Events/Competitions** ~ major events or competitions held in your country, when are they held, history on how they got started.
