CINCO DE MAYO

Everyone loves Cinco de Mayo! The holiday provides the perfect opportunity to honor Mexican culture, listen and dance to some festive music, and munch on some crunchy tacos. But what's this holiday really about?

WHAT IS CINCO DE MAYO?

- 1 Cinco de Mayo celebrates a victory by the Mexican Army over the French Army in the Battle of Puebla on May 5, 1862.
- 2 Mexico was in massive debt and owed many countries money, including France, Great Britain, and Spain. Unfortunately, Mexico was bankrupt at the time, so President Benito Juarez decided to suspend all payment of foreign debt. Mexico simply didn't have the money. This angered Great Britain, Spain, and France. The three nations agreed to work together to force Mexico to pay. In December 1861, they arrived off the coast of Veracruz in order to battle for the money they were owed. Desperate last-minute diplomatic efforts by the Juarez administration persuaded Britain and Spain that a war would only further devastate the Mexican

economy (which was in no one's best interest). Spanish and British forces left with promise of future payment. France, however, was unconvinced and French forces remained on Mexican soil.



3 Early on May 5, 1862, General Laurencez led 6,000 well equipped and well trained French troops toward Puebla, Mexico. The Mexican army, on the other hand, consisted of 4,000 troops (many of them agricultural workers armed with antiquated rifles and machetes). It was no surprise that the French had already beaten the Mexicans a few times as they made their way into the city of Puebla. No one thought the Mexicans were going to win the battle... except maybe the Mexicans!

4 The Mexicans had made defenses around the city of Puebla. The French attacked three times, and each time they had to retreat. When the French cannons ran out of ammunition, the Mexican commander, Ignacio Zaragoza, ordered an attack. The Mexican attack forced the French to retreat for good.

THE SIGNIFICANCE OF CINCO DE MAYO

- The importance of the Battle of Puebla was the concept that a smaller, poorly equipped army could defeat a larger, well-equipped one. The Mexican people also showed that they were willing to defend their homeland from invaders. This victory also provided a stunning revelation to the rest of the world, which held the belief that European governments and armies were by their very nature more powerful than other, smaller countries and their armies.
- 6 President Juarez was so proud of his army's accomplishment that he declared May 5th a national holiday. It was referred to as "Battle of Puebla Day" or "Battle of Cinco Mayo Day".

CELEBRATE

- Mexicans love Cinco de Mayo! It's a day that makes them feel very proud. There are parties, parades, and lots of food. There are festivals with concerts and dancing. Mariachi bands are everywhere (see sidebar).
- 8 Celebrations in the city of Puebla are probably the best. After all, that's where the big battle was! There is a huge parade with over 20,000 participants and a re-enactment of the battle. There is also a mole festival. Mole, pronounced mo-lay, is a spicy/sweet, rich sauce that originated in Puebla. The festival

Mariachi

Mariachi is a type of musical ensemble that originated in Mexico. The size of the group can vary quite a bit, but ideally there are six violins, two trumpets, and three rhythm instruments including a guitar, a vihuela (a high-pitched, five-string guitar) and one guitarrón (a small-scaled acoustic bass guitar). There is not a lead singer in Mariachi. Everyone in the ensemble does some vocalization even if it is just during the chorus parts. Different members sing the lead in different songs. It is common practice to match the voice with the type of song that is being performed so that the emotion of the piece is conveyed in the most artistic way possible.



includes discussions and demonstrations about how to create the savory sauce, along with tastings of mole sauce prepared by leading international, national, and regional chefs.

Note to Reader: Although Cinco de Mayo is a significant holiday in Mexico, it is not quite as popular as Mexico's Independence Day (from Spain) which is celebrated on September 16th.

CINCO DE MAYO IN THE UNITED STATES

- 9 In the United States, Cinco de Mayo is widely interpreted as a celebration of Mexican culture and heritage, particularly in areas with substantial Mexican-American populations. Today, revelers mark the occasion with parades, parties, mariachi music, Mexican folk dancing, and traditional foods such as tacos and mole poblano (see recipe below).
- 10 Some of the more popular festivals are held in Los Angeles, Chicago, and Houston. Fiesta Broadway is the largest Cinco de Mayo celebration in the world. Up to half of a million people come out for this annual street party in downtown Los Angeles. There is food, fun, and games for the whole family.

MOLE POBLANO

Total Time: 1 hr 5 min Prep: 45 min Cook: 20 minutes Yield:2 servings

Ingredients

- -1/4 pound sesame seeds
- -Olive oil, for cooking
- -1/4 pound almonds
- -1/4 pound peanuts
- -3 bananas or plantains
- -1 pound raisins
- -1/4 pound tomatoes
- -1 pound fire roasted poblano chiles, rehydrated in water
- -1/4 teaspoon aniseeds
- -1/4 teaspoon cinnamon
- -1 ounce unsweetened Mexican chocolate
- -2 pre-cooked turkey legs

Directions

In a medium saute pan, toast sesame seeds and place in food processor. In same saute pan add oil and fry almonds. Remove almonds, place in food processor, and fry peanuts. Remove peanuts, place in food processor, and fry plantains. Remove plantains, place in food processor, and fry raisins. Remove raisins and place in food processor. Remove all but one tablespoon oil and fry tomatoes.

In a food processor grind together sesame seeds, almonds, peanuts, plantains, raisins, tomatoes, poblanos, aniseeds, and cinnamon; this is the mole. Thin with left over chile water. In large saucepan, heat oil. Add mole and cook in oil to bring out flavors. Add chocolate. When melted, add pre-cooked turkey legs and simmer until the turkey is heated through.
